RE: Wage Package effective June 1, 2010

Please be advised that effective June 1, 2010 through November 30, 2010 the wage and fringe benefit package for Residential Wiremen under the Residential Wiring Agreement will change as follows:

Health & Welfare - increase by \$0.35 to \$9.74
